

## Press Corps: Position Paper Guide

Hello Delegates,

As this committee is slightly different from other ones, the position papers should also look slightly different. We expect them to be no more than two A4 pages long, and cover:

- **An introduction to your given news outlet**
  - Where do they come from?
  - Who do they write for?
  - Who owns them?
  - What issues are often addressed in their articles?
  - Do they have any political biases?
- **Their position on Topic 1 - "Addressing the Effects of Private Corporation Funding on the Breadth and Depth of Coverage of Controversial Global issues"**
  - How are they impacted by corporate funding?
  - Do they believe it should be limited?
- **Some responses to the questions listed in the Topic 1 study guide**
  - These should reflect the opinions of your news outlet, but we are looking for creative, innovative and original solutions
- **A demonstration of the writing style of your news outlet**
  - Use any topic of your choice

In terms of formatting, there are no specifics, though we would suggest writing in full sentences rather than relying heavily on notes and bullet points. Be as creative as you like: as long as you address the prompts, we are sure you'll do a great job.
